Fees

€3,000 Tuition fee for a semester in 2026

Students can purchase additional services at an extra cost, such as insurance, visa, and accommodation, which are separate and the responsibility of the student. Flights from your home city to Invercargill must be paid for and arranged by the student.

To be paid before arrival

\$155 per week shared accommodation

This is payable from arrival and can be paid weekly, fortnightly or monthly depending on your situation on an as per use basis

\$200 NZD Welcome pack for accommodation

To be paid before arrival - this is to cover your linen and towel hire for your stay

\$400 bond NZD

This is paid on arrival and is refundable upon checkout of your apartment if you have met the apartment requirements during your stay and do not have any unpaid fees owing.
