

Hygiene concept for Flensburg University of Applied Sciences' Menke-Planetarium in Glücksburg

The present hygiene concept was passed by the President's Office of Flensburg University of Applied Sciences (FUAS) and will be published on the Planetarium's website as well as on its social media accounts and its notice board.

The Planetarium Glücksburg will open for the public on 1 August 2020; the following rules and regulations as well as those laid out in the general hygiene concept of FUAS will be adhered to.

The validity of the concept is based on the corona-related measures in place for the Land of Schleswig-Holstein.

1. Organisation of the access to events at the Planetarium

There are 50 fixed seats in the planetarium's dome theatre. While corona-related protective measures are in place a maximum of 11 visitors will be allowed per show.

These are the rules in place:

- Persons belonging to one household (parents with their children) may sit next to each other. There will be a minimum distance of 1.5 metres each way between them and the next family/individual. Planetarium staff will inform visitors prior to each show. Seats which must not be used are marked in an appropriate manner.
- Tickets can only be ordered online or by phone. Distance markers in front of the building, in the building's entrance area and at ticket counter will ensure that the minimum distance of 1.5 metres is kept by everyone entering the Planetarium.
- A transparent screen will separate the ticket counter from the visitors. Visitors are required to wear a mask covering the mouth and nose while they are in the entrance area and at the ticket counter; this will be indicated at the entrance.
- The entrance area to the Planetarium will be opened 15 minutes before the beginning of a show at the earliest. Visitors will exit the Planetarium individually after a show. There will be enough time between individual shows to rule out encounters between visitors and to allow for thorough airing.
- FUAS provides hand sanitizer to be made available in the entrance area, visitors will be able to disinfect their hands immediately before and after each show.
- Information about the hygiene rules in different languages will be posted at the entrance door, in the entrance area and in the sanitary facilities.

2. Communication with visitors and registration

Staff will point out the hygiene rules (distance keeping, hand hygiene, coughing and sneezing etiquette) to visitors before the start of each show.

Visitors must put their name, address, phone number and e-mail address into a list that will be kept for a six-week period in compliance with the valid data protection rules in order to be able to track possible infection chains. These lists are to be handed to the health department in charge if required.

3. Disinfection measures

- Soap, sinks and disposable towels from towel dispensers will be provided in the sanitary facilities.
- All publically accessible door handles will be treated with disinfectant after each show and before new visitors enter the Planetarium.
- No food and drink may be consumed inside the Planetarium.
- The ventilation system will run on the highest level of fresh air mode between shows, during shows the performance of the ventilation system will be increased.
